WCC whelps several litters of Golden Retrievers and Labradors each year, and we always have adult service dogs in training at the site who need your loving care.

WCC Dog Care Technicians play an important role in the organization by helping maintain the health and wellbeing of dogs and puppies at our Healing Quarters. All dog care team members are expected to work collaboratively and perform all duties in a responsible, timely, and professional manner.

What the job involves:

- Feeding dogs / puppies
- Cleaning crates and dog areas
- Scooping yards
- Washing dishes and doing laundry
- Recording dog care related information
- Employee must be on time for all shifts and arrive ready to work
- Communicating with Manager in a timely manner

Shifts and Hours:

- Current available shifts are:
 - Nights (typically 5-9p, M-F)
 - Weekends (typically 7:30a -130p and 3-9)
 - Holidays (typically 7:30a -130p and 3-9)
- Required to have 1 regular shift that is the same day/night every week.
- Required to choose at least 1 other shift each week, from the remaining shifts.
- Must work at least one Friday or Saturday night per month.
- Must be available during most holidays.

Required Experience, Skills, Background:

- Ability to comfortably interact with dogs (and one or more onsite cats).
- Detail oriented and demonstrably strong work ethic – this can be demanding work.
- Friendly, calm, mature, patient, and professional demeanor with good communication skills.
- The ability to work independently with limited supervision – you must learn quickly.
- Ability to learn and manage a variety of tasks and processes.
- Capable of performing duties that require regular bending, lifting, stooping, stretching, and performing other tasks related to the care of large breed service dogs.
- This is a part-time position.



Desirable Qualifications:

- Previous experience in a kennel environment.
