This unique role combines hands-on service dog training with volunteer and administrative coordination. The successful candidate will train Golden Retrievers and Labradors to become service dogs for Veterans, while also coordinating volunteers, supporting program operations, and advancing WCC's Mission Based Trauma Recovery (MBTR) model.

This is a mission-driven position that directly impacts the lives of Service Members and Veterans coping with combat-related stress, while strengthening WCC's community presence and volunteer engagement.

This is a full-time position with occasional weekend/evening hours.

What the job involves:

Service Dog Training & MBTR Program Delivery

- Train service dogs from puppyhood through IFT placement, following WCC training methodology and Assistance Dogs International standards.
- Lead one-on-one and group training sessions with Warrior Trainers, Puppy Parents, and volunteers.
- Provide MBTR services to recovering Warriors and their families at designated program sites in the Pittsburgh area (e.g., Duquesne University).
- Monitor and evaluate service dogs in training, maintain accurate training records, and make placement recommendations.
- Groom, care for, and transport dogs for veterinary exams and preventive care.
- Communicate with Puppy Parents regarding schedules, training progress, and problem behaviors.
- Support MBTR program compliance with HIPAA, patient goals, and facility regulations.

Volunteer & Administrative Management

- Recruit, onboard, and supervise Puppy Parents, Puppy Sitters, and volunteers.
- Create schedules and assignments that meet program needs and KPI goals.
- Maintain accurate records, documentation, and data entry in Salesforce.
- Coordinate volunteer classes, track attendance, and follow up with participants.
- Support community outreach, fundraising, and semi-annual celebrations.
- Represent WCC at events, presentations, and donor collaborations.
- Maintain inventory of canine supplies and equipment.

- Build and sustain relationships with referring agencies, community partners, and sponsors.
- Attend community events to further our mission.
- Assist with social media initiatives (e.g., Yappy Hour, Puppy Yoga).
- Support release dog placements and graduate team recertifications.
